The Los Angeles County Development Authority (LACDA) continues to serve current participants of our Single-Family Home Improvement Program (SFHIP), Handyworker Grant Program (HW), and Mobile Home Improvement Grant Program (MIP) during this unprecedented time. Although the LACDA's offices are closed to the public, our staff is working diligently to ensure all program participants continue to be assisted. Q. Is the LACDA currently closed for business?

A. Yes. While our offices are closed to the public, we will remain available to our current program participants and interested homeowners. All essential business will continue to be conducted via email at SFHIP@lacda.org.

Q. Can I still apply for SFHIP, HW, or MIP?

A. Yes. You may request a pre-application by contacting the designated Project Manager for your Supervisorial District (see below). Once you have been pre-screened, the Project Manager will mail a program application to you.

Q. I have already submitted my application. How do I get an update on the status?

A. Once the Project Manager receives your application, it will be reviewed for completeness and the accuracy of all information will be verified. The Project Manager will contact you either by phone or email to inform you of the status, typically within five (5) business days.

Q. My SFHIP, HW, or MIP improvements are currently on hold. Why has all work stopped?

A. The LACDA has directed all contractors to temporarily suspend construction on all SFHIP, HW, and MIP projects due to the ongoing concerns regarding the COVID-19 virus. You will be notified once it is determined to be safe to resume construction activities.
